What You'll Do

We are seeking a highly qualified and Montessori certified Lead Teacher who shares our passion for an anti-biased anti-racist application of the Montessori method for our founding classroom. The Lead Teacher is entrepreneurial leader who has the talent, innovation, and perseverance required to work both within the classroom as the children's first teacher and outside the classroom (alongside the President) to secure funding, grow enrollment, attract and retain great staff, build a strong parent community, and ensure the educational experience for each child in every classroom is of the highest standard. As Teacher-Leader, you will report to the President of the school.

Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Co-develop the mission and vision of the organization while embodying the mission and vision of The Foundation for Black Excellence
- Work directly with the President to develop a strategic plan for the campus
- With support from FBE schools, find and prepare a school site
- Design and create a prepared Montessori environment in alignment with the vision of FBE Schools

- Actively market your school to recruit and enroll a socioeconomically diverse mix of children and families
- Create a strong culture that embodies the mission of our organization
- Build a strong community among all stakeholders including staff, parents, and children
- Manage the campus budget
- Work with the President to ensure enrollment targets are met
- Hire, support, develop, and manage teaching staff
- Serve as lead teacher, working directly within a Montessori classroom
- Plan and execute small staff-wide professional development sessions as needed
- Co-manage assigned aspects of school-wide operational routines such as arrival / dismissal procedures, lunch, recess, etc.
- Develop, support, and maintain a culture of high behavioral and academic expectations rooted in liberatory practices that ensures every child is in a position to learn alongside peers and adults
- Participate in additional school-related activities including field trips, parent and community meetings, and other programs as needed throughout the year
- Develop deep and meaningful relationships with the local community
- Lead (with direct support) the hiring of the founding team for the school campus
